2017 Public Supply Annual Report Completion and Water Audit Workshop

The 2017 Public Supply Annual Reports are due by April 1, 2018. The District is holding free workshops to aid in the completion of the Public Supply Annual Report. This report is an important source of information for the District's water supply planning, water use permitting, and water conservation programs.

The District will also provide a workshop on water audits. This workshop will cover regulatory requirements for water audits as well as technical information on conducting water audits to identify sources of water loss in utility distribution systems. Participants will learn about tracking sources of water loss and how updates to utility operations can help aid in reducing water loss and recovering revenue water.

Who Should Attend:

Water utility staff/representatives responsible for completion of the Public Supply Annual Report will benefit most from attending one of these workshops. Additionally, utility staff interested in improving water accounting and implementing water loss prevention strategies would benefit from attending the water audit workshop. There is no charge for the workshops.

- Review newly updated Utility and District Demographics web site
- Demonstrate how to calculate service area functional population using District tools
- Answer any questions about specific sections of the Public Supply Annual Report
