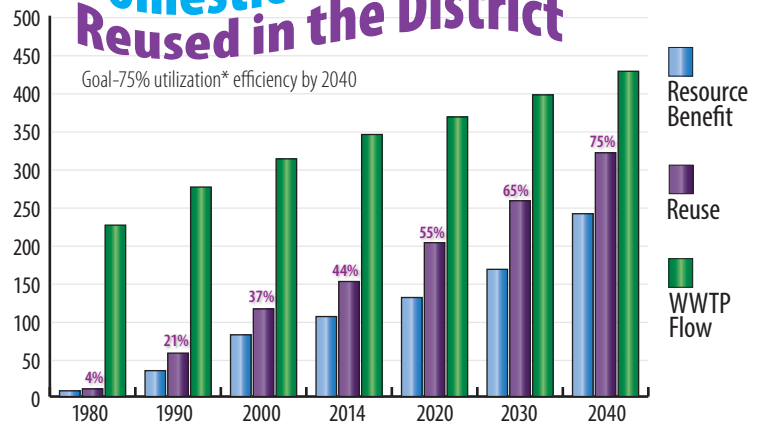

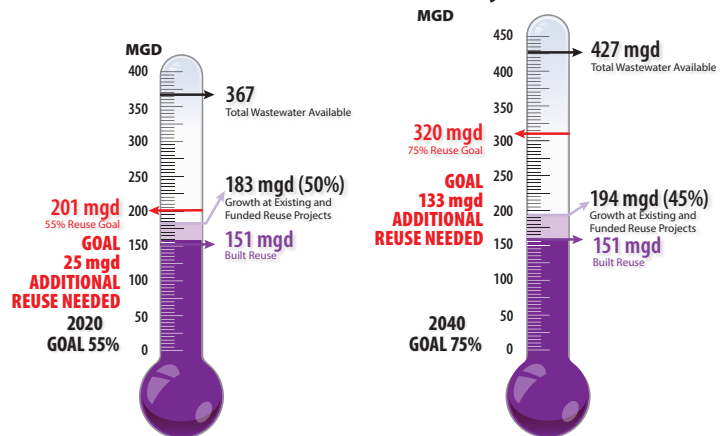

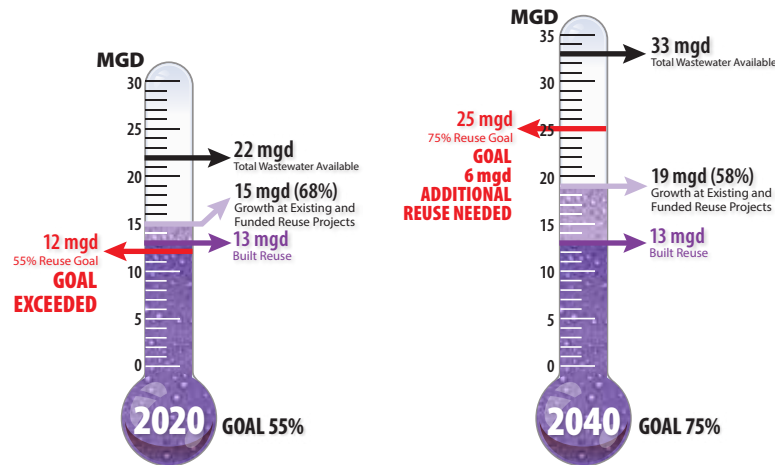


2020-2040 Reuse Goals Districtwide

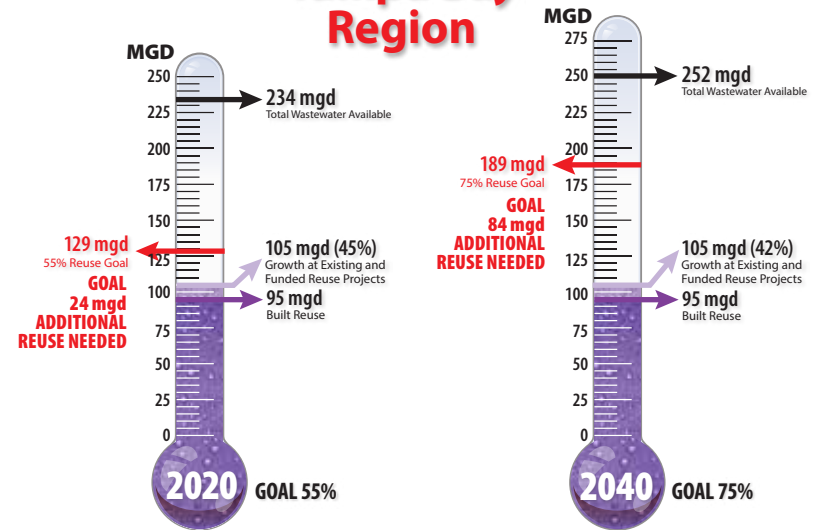

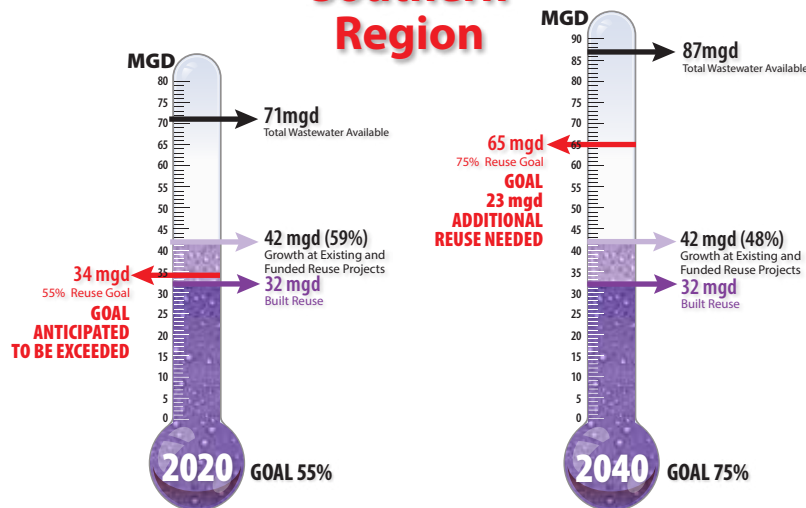
