The Council shall have the powers and duties to: 1) Review audits and all data specifically related to lake and river restoration techniques and sports fish population recovery strategies, including data and strategies for shoreline restoration, sand and other sediment control and removal, exotic species management, floating tussock management or removal, navigation, water quality, and fish and wildlife habitat improvement; 2) Evaluate whether additional studies are needed; 3) Explore all possible sources of funding to conduct the restoration activities; 4) Report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate before November 25 of each year on the progress of the Citrus/Hernando Waterways restoration program and any recommendations for the next fiscal year.
